How vehicle is defective / has deficiencies. Repairs required:

Substantial oil leak from engine, dripping onto road surface.
Power steering box, substantial oil leak.

DEFECT NOTICE CATEGORY:

 Minor* Major**

Formal Warning (light vehicle only): You are not required to produce this vehicle for inspection. The faults must be rectified without delay.

Self-clearing defect (heavy vehicle only): Corrective action must be taken by a stated day (the due day) after the notice is issued. After the due day, the vehicle must not be used, on a road unless corrective action has been taken. You are not required to produce this vehicle for inspection.

 Tick applicable instructions:-

This vehicle may only be used on a road up to the due time / day being 8 hours from the time and date of this notice. A light vehicle may subsequently be driven directly to a place of repair.

This vehicle must have the faults rectified immediately or be towed / carried away.

*Heavy vehicles issued a minor defect notice must have corrective action taken by the stated time (due time) above. After the due time the vehicle must not be used on a road unless corrective action has been taken.

**Heavy vehicles with a major defect notice must not be used on a road after the notice is issued other than to move it to one or more locations stated in this notice in one or more ways stated in this notice.

The following conditions form part of this notice: motor direct travel to PT Adelaide to unload, then direct travel to ADELAIDE

Once relevant repairs have been carried out a heavy vehicle issued with a major defect notice may be used on a road to be taken to a place to be inspected for the purpose of enabling the defect notice to be cleared if the vehicle is not carrying goods or passengers and the use of the vehicle does not pose a safety risk.

After repairs have been carried out to remedy deficiencies described on this notice, the vehicle may be driven to the nominated place for inspection (Do not drive or permit an unregistered vehicle on a road).

The defect notice must be cleared at: Other Nominated Place: NOT FOR POLICE USE Vehicle Inspection Station South Australia Police Station
