

Hello Buyers,

This is the Liquidated Dentist. There is a story behind the name obviously, but it is not for these pages. What I would like to do is to thank Grays and give a background and better descriptions to the next few auction items. I have been extremely impressed with the professionalism and expertise that the Grays team has shown during this difficult time. Liquidating your business of 25 years is a tough thing. Grays has made life that little bit better by simplifying the process. In our first auction Grays catalogued and listed well over 100 items for sale. Only 3 (including this chair) didn't sell. I was very impressed with the efficiency and overall result. Highly recommended if you find yourself in need to liquidate quickly (I hope you never need to).

I am truly surprised that this Sirona C2 dental chair did not sell during the first auction. I was seriously going to let it go at \$9 with no reserve. Now, I am aiming to sell it for fair value. My C5 dental chair sold for \$29 to a very astute young dentist that recognized value when he saw it. The Teneo dental chair sold for over \$17,000 which I thought was a steal too. Anyway, let me quickly tell you about the Grays auction process and the history of this Sirona C2 dental chair. I recently contacted Grays to quickly liquidate the contents of my surgery. Why? Because I have to stripout my surgery completely to get to some fairly dangerous, unhealthy mold in the subfloor. My surgery sprung a leak from a water filter about 4 years ago. My staff and I were on annual leave and were not around to rectify the issue until it was too late. Then Covid struck and everything was delayed. To cut a long story short, legal action against my insurance company only finished late last year. I now have the sole responsibility of rectifying all issues.

Prior to the insurance event this dental chair was fully functional. After the insurance event, I have not been able to test if the chair is functional as the insurance company's installer decided to pull out the main transformer and did not replace it. They assure me it is fully functional if a new transformer is installed. This is where Grays comes in with the auction process - the items are sold AS IS with full disclosure to the best of our knowledge. There is a Transference of Risk to the Buyer which is why the auction prices are sometimes absolute bargains. Please understand that when you are bidding on this or any item. You are buying it under auction conditions AS IS. If you win the auction, it is legally yours. No backsies. For your peace of mind, three dental technician teams have looked at the chair and say it is in great condition for its vintage. They are willing to transport and install it in the Sydney region at the minimum bid price. However, please do call them to confirm the details. Interstate buyers, please understand transportation costs can be quite prohibitive. The technician teams are listed below

Sirona C2 Dental Chair Details

- Bought new and installed in June 2000
- Top of the line German Made unit back when Sirona was still mainly Siemens...
- 5x Sprayvit triplex tips includes (yes the \$300 per tip ones)
- 1x High speed Sirona coupling
- 1x E-type Electric motor installed in chair
- 1x E-type Electric motor on bracket table (possibly not working? Unsure why it is not on the chair)
- 1x Sirona Ultrasonic Scaler
- 1x Sirona Electrosurgery inbuilt in chair (This is a game changer for all subgingival work like clearing deep prep margins)
- Box of Sirona Electrosurgery tips (\$200 per tip from memory)
- Overhead light
- High velocity suction
- Low velocity suction
- Sirocam 2 Intraoral Camera (works with Sidexis XG but I never got it working with Sidexis 4)
- Box of Sirocam 2 sleeves
- Chair maintenance kit
- Sirona kids booster seat
- Custom modified Isolite power plug - Great for CEREC

This dental chair was my first and favorite dental chair (yes, even better than a fully equipped Sirona Teneo with Massage function). I am hoping that it goes to a new home as it would be a perfect backup chair that would probably get used as your primary once you realize how convenient having an inbuilt electrosurgery unit is.
