The Captain Cleanup Clean Machine

The Keep Australia Beautiful Council of WA commissioned the Carlisle TAFE to build a car that would befit an Australian Environmental Super Hero. It needed to look futuristic and be able to accommodate students to ride in the back.

A 1976 Holden HX Ute was chosen as the skeleton for Captain Cleanup's car which was designed, custom built and painted by the Trades Staff and Students of Carlisle Technical College finished on October 9, 1981.

In 2003 the car had a makeover from Pebco Automotives Services and a gas conversion by Mews Auto Gas services in 2006.

The car has travelled all over WA for the last 40 years thrilling and delighting over a million primary and high school students who were lucky enough to have a ride in the back of Captain Cleanup's Clean Machine, helping him keep Australia beautiful.
